- 1. You must include 12 of the **Key words** above **if** you are working **alone**, and include **ALL** the **Key words** if you are working with a **partner/group**. Use your notes, assignments, book, and research for information about the key words.
- 2. Key words must go in the correct order by date
- 3. Each Key Word must include a picture, or drawing representation
- 4. Be as specific as you can. You must include at least a paragraph describing each event.
 - C = Will only write about the: Who, What, When, Where, How, and Why for each event.
 - B = Will write about the: Who, What, When, Where, How, and Why for each event, plus discuss the significance or importance of the event/topic in history.
 - A = Will write about the: Who, What, When, Where, How, and Why
 for each event, discuss the significance or importance of the
 event/topic in history, and explain the legacy or impact of the
 event today
 - The more information displayed in your timeline or brochure the more you can earn for completeness.
- 5. Use a large sheet of paper for the timeline (NOT 8x11). The brochure needs to be bounded together (OK 8x11), or folded appropriately.
- 6. Include your Name, and Title on the front of your project
- 7. Include a Bibliography/Work Cited page on the back or last page.
- 8. Neatness, Color, No Pencil, Good information, and Use of all key terms, are all important to maximize your grade!
