Requirements:


1. You must include 12 of the Key words above if you are working alone, and include ALL the Key words if you are working with a partner/group. Use your notes, assignments, book, and research for information about the key words.
2. Key words must go in the correct order by date
3. Each Key Word must include a picture, or drawing representation
4. Be as specific as you can. You must include at least a paragraph describing each event.

- $C=$ Will only write about the: Who, What, When, Where, How, and Why for each event.
- $B=$ Will write about the: Who, What, When, Where, How, and Why for each event, plus discuss the significance or importance of the event/topic in history.
- $A=$ Will write about the: Who, What, When, Where, How, and Why for each event, discuss the significance or importance of the event/topic in history, and explain the legacy or impact of the event today
- The more information displayed in your timeline or brochure the more you can earn for completeness.

5. Use a large sheet of paper for the timeline (NOT $8 \times 11$ ). The brochure needs to be bounded together (OK $8 \times 11$ ), or folded appropriately.
6. Include your Name, and Title on the front of your project
7. Include a Bibliography/Work Cited page on the back or last page.
8. Neatness, Color, No Pencil, Good information, and Use of all key terms, are all important to maximize your grade!
